Created in 1974, the AGRHYMET Regional Center is a specialized institution of the Permanent Inter-State Committee for Drought Control in the Sahel (CILSS) which is composed of nine member States. Its principal objectives are i) contribute to food security and to increase agricultural production in the CILSS member countries and ii) help to improve natural resource management in the Sahel region by ensuring the training and information of the development stakeholders and their partners in the fields of agro-ecology in the wide sense (agro-climatology, hydrology, plant protection...). AGRHYMET is a regional tool that is specialized in the sciences and techniques applicable to the agricultural development sectors, the development of the rural sub-space and natural resource management. Over the years, the AGRHYMET Regional Center has proven to be a center of excellence in areas concerning:

- Training of officials from the countries of the Sahel and elsewhere;
- Agro-meteorological and hydrological monitoring at the regional level;
- Agricultural statistics and crop monitoring in the Sahel and in West Africa;

I. RESPONSIBILITIES

Leadership

- Efficiently directing the implementation of the strategic Plan of the Institution and the attainment of the objectives of the 2009-2013 five year plan and the implementation of financing together with the Coordinators of the PRA;
- Closely monitor the proper application of the CILSS policies and procedures;
- Develop the corporate image and improve the visibility of the Center at both the regional and international levels;
- Be accountable for the efficient and effective execution of the operations of the Center;
- Promote the exchange of experiences and formalize partnerships with all African or international organizations having objectives that are similar to those of CILSS and the AGRHYMET Regional Center;
- Mobilize additional financial resources within the framework of these partnerships.

Management

- Effectively give directives to the technical, scientific, administrative, financial and accounting departments of the Center through the guidance of the heads of these departments;

II. QUALIFICATION OF THE CANDIDATE:

Qualification

- Be holder of a university degree(MBA, MSc, Doctorate-PhD) in the following fields: Meteorology, Agro-meteorology, Agronomy, Agro-economics, Bio-climatology, Environmental Science, Management or related areas, or any other equivalent degree.

Experience

- Demonstrate at least ten (10) years pertinent experience in one of the above fields in relation to the exigencies of the post;
- Must have occupied a position of responsibility in the management and coordination of scientific, technical or pedagogic activities;
- Must have a good experience in the management of organizations;

Skills
